We had the privilege to meet with some 350 believers from the Eastern Uganda area from April 1st to 3rd and took up the subject of the Great Salvation, emphasising the truths of Forgiveness, Justification, Redemption, Reconciliation, Salvation, and New Birth. The book by F.B. Hole, The Great Salvation, was printed in English and provided to all who would purchase a copy. The



brethren in Uganda also translated this book into Luganda (the main language most Ugandans speak) and







this was also provided at a very reduced price. We thank the Lord for the sincere interest on the part of the attendees. Much emphasis was put on the blessed truth of being justified by faith apart from works, which truth the Devil has attempted to destroy everywhere, including in the continent of Africa in a very real way. However, He that is in us is greater than he that is in the world, and we are thankful that the message


first spoken by the Lord Himself is finding entrance into the hearts of many.







to hear their personal exercises regarding the work in their areas, and what are some of the greatest needs. It is so encouraging to hear how a work that started many years ago by our late brother and sister Ernie and Marylin Barnes is still bringing forth fruit! "This is the Lord's doing and it is marvellous in our eyes" Mark 12:11. Brother Festo remembers the

"gospel tent" as a little boy, and brother Taha likewise remembers the hard work of brother Ernie and sister Marylin. Brother Gerard comes out of the strong Pentecostal Charismatic movement that has so many Africans in its bondage. After a long spiritual journey, searching and seeking, the Lord answered his prayer with John 8:36 "if the Son makes you free, **you shall be free** indeed.

As far as the needs are concerned, there is a common cry.....we need help. Yes, all understand it is the Lord's work, and we are simply His servants, and He will accomplish His purpose. But the work is great, and the needs are many.

A particular need expressed is for **youth camps** with help from English speaking young people who would have a sincere desire before the Lord to help local brethren with this work. When you begin to understand that in the typical African culture, the family unit does not function in the God ordered way. The children are basically taught by the government run school system with its own social agenda that is far from anything biblical, and not that which scripture sets out as Christian behaviour in this world. One means to attempt to address this is through youth camps.


Please also pray for more funds for the growing number of needy people in the BCC. Please pray for this violence to stop and that the saints can live their lives in a measure of peace.
